Lectio Divina & Centering Prayer Group

On the next two Tuesdays, in this last month of the Church year, we will continue our Lectio Divina reflections on the writing of the woman recluse, whom we know from the name of the parish church of St Julian in Norwich. The cell in which she lived was attached to the church. Julian felt it was laid upon her to write, and she writes for all her fellow Christians. In what sense then, can it be said that Julian was writing for us, we who have little awareness of the strangeness of life in medieval England. Yet as different as our world is from Julian's there is a combination of steadiness and venturesomeness in the writing about her experiences of God: that she saw 'no wrath in God', that 'God is everything that is good'.

During Advent Tuesday Lectio Divina will focus on Hope.
