In 1949, millions of refugees were starving in war-ravaged Europe. As the Reverend Frank Byatt, a young Methodist Minister, looked at his heavily-laden Christmas dinner table, the contrast between our abundance in Australia and the needs of others around the world could not have been starker. He called his congregation to '*get a bowl on your Christmas dinner table as a Bowl of Remembrance and see if you can get everybody round the table to make a generous gift so that you can share your good dinner with hungry children in other lands*'.

Since then the Christmas Bowl has provided Christian help around the world.
