R E F L E C T I O N

"Abide in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me, I am the vine, you are the branches." John 15. 4

Because it is the last Sunday before Ascension Day, the texts of the sixth Sunday of Easter in effect become the last words of the resurrected Jesus to his friends. Jesus, about to ascend to heaven, leaves this instruction: **"Love one another as I have loved you."**

As I have loved you: radical love of enemies, the poor, despised tax collectors, sinners, prostitutes, lepers. Relentless challenges to the righteous and pious; truth telling, table overturning, and finally cross bearing and death embracing, and laying down your life for your friends.

I'd feel better if Jesus really ascended far away into heaven, remotely busying himself at the "right hand of the Father." Unfortunately, the enthronement takes place within each and every heart. Your own hear. My imperfect heart.

Loving one another as he loved us, is, indeed a most intimate commandment. And every year, I'm not sure I'm up to it.
